



Frequent Questions:

- 1- Bilingualism is up to which grade in the school?
The school is bilingual up to Year 6. In Senior school, the subjects are taught in Spanish, with the English subject having 6 hrs/week.
The students have the possibility to take the appropriate Cambridge Certificate Exam according to their level. These are Starters, Movers, Ket and Pet. The students in Year 12 are obliged to take the English First Certificate Exam.
- 2- How many students are in each class?
Each class has approximately 30 students.
- 3- What after school activities does the school offer?
After School Activities (ASA) include sports clubs, reinforcement classes in English, Spanish and Maths and higher learning classes in Maths, Science and Spanish.
- 4- Are the teachers' bilingual?
The teachers in Infant and Junior school are bilingual, except the teachers who teach the subjects in Spanish (Spanish, Music, Physical Education and Religion).
- 5- Where do the students eat lunch? Is there a dining room? What is the food like?
The school has an airconditioned dining room for the students to eat their lunch in. Students can bring their own cold packed lunch, lunch that they would like to reheat or buy a ticket for the school lunch. The school lunch is a healthy menu specially designed that varies from month to month and can be viewed on the school web page.
- 6- Is there an Orientation team?
There is an integrated Orientation team consisting of a child psychologist and 2 guidance counsellors who assist in the integral development of our students.
- 7- How many teachers are in Year 1?
There are two teachers, one class teacher and a co-teacher. The subjects are taught by different teachers.

8- Which classes eat lunch in school?

Students from Year 3 to Year 12 eat lunch in school.

9- What is the time that the school day starts? Is it the same for all students?

All of the students enter classes at the same time-07:45 hrs.

The end of the school day varies.

Infant school-13:00 hrs.

Year1 and Year2-14:25 hrs.

Year 3 to Year 10- 15:40 hrs.

Year 11 and Year 12- 16:25 hrs.

10-What technological equipment do the classrooms have?

All of the Infant and Junior classrooms have a Smart T.V., in Senior school they have overhead projectors. The students from Year 3 to Year 12 use tablets in their English program.

11-What infrastructure does the school have?

The school has a science laboratory, a computer laboratory, a music room, a library, a football pitch with synthetic grass, a basketball court, an indoor gymnasium and general areas for relaxation.

12-How many hours of sport do the students do weekly?

The students from Infant, Junior and Year 7 and Year 8 from the Senior school have 4 hours of sport a week. Years 11 and 12 have 2 hours of sport a week.
